If you require any further information about joining the electoral roll or help filling in the form correctly, please contact any of the above. Thank you. The new Roll will come into operation on **2nd May 2025**

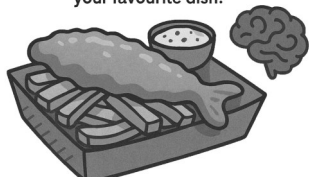

## Easter Day

Something happened in the night. Long before the first light of day, before anyone was around to witness it, before any human hand or faith could claim any involvement or revelation, God acted in the dark.

Somewhere on the edge of a sleeping city is a tomb. The stone that sealed its entrance has been rolled away, and the tomb is found empty. The first person to witness the resurrection is a woman, Mary Magdalene. It is interesting that the first experience of resurrection is of loss and emptiness. This was, in a sense, another cruel twist in a story that already left them frightened, traumatized, and uncomprehending. Where was Jesus' body?

Perhaps the key action in all of this, the key moment, is the fact that Mary turns to look at Jesus. It is often turning to Jesus in moments of confusion, desperation, and pain that we understand the power of resurrection life. Jesus calls us by name.

Easter is a day like no other. The powers of death, hell, sin, and the evil one have been trampled on by Jesus and we can proclaim the ancient words:

**Alleluia: Christ is Risen,  
He is Risen indeed Alleluia!**
