Message

The cost and freedom of following Jesus:

Bible readings for this week (1 Kings, Galatians, and Luke) all ask the same thing: what does it actually mean to follow Jesus?

When God called a farmer named Elisha, he did something mad. He killed all his cattle and burned his farming tools to cook a huge barbecue for everyone in his village. Why? Because he was making sure he couldn't change his mind and go back to his old life when things got hard.

Paul writes to some Christians about real freedom. Not the "do what you want" freedom that everyone goes on about these days, but freedom from the stuff that actually messes us up - feeling guilty all the time, being ashamed, and trying desperately to make everyone like us. Proper freedom means we can love people and help them because we want to, not because someone's making us.

Jesus meets three blokes who want to follow him, but they all want get-out clauses and backup plans. His point is simple: you can't follow God half-heartedly.

All three stories show us the same thing: following Jesus means letting go of some things, but what we get back is miles better. We're not swapping something good for something rubbish - we're trading wobbly, temporary stuff for solid gold that lasts forever.
