Dear friends.

esus is the king who is the very embodiment of justice, of loyalty, of forgiveness, of the salvation of God. On the cross, lesus prays for his executioners. He is marked as a false king and treated as though he were some kind of clown or impostor.

n the cross, lesus brings to us God's promise of a Kingdom which is rooted in justice and mercy. On the cross, Jesus rescues those who turn to him and his Kingdom when there is no other hope. Jesus is the shepherd who is the embodiment of the faithfulness of God, the firstborn from the dead. The cross reveals the complete splendour of God's majesty - not with royal robes or dominion, but with grace and mercy.

esus makes peace with this broken creation distorted by sin and evil. Making peace can be a bloody business. We see this throughout the world and throughout history. The cross brings reconciliation between humanity and God. The living God has come among us to share our human image - the man who is God. Extraordinary.

n Jesus life can emerge from death, glory from shame, restoration from ruin. This is good news.
