Message from the Rector

Pentecost is one of the most extraordinary moments in the whole of the Bible. Fifty days after Easter, the disciples were gathered in Jerusalem when the Holy Spirit came upon them like wind and fire, and they began speaking in the languages of people from across the known world. Those who heard them were astonished - each person hearing the good news of Jesus in their own language, their own dialect, their own cultural tongue.

This was not an accident. Read against the whole sweep of scripture, Pentecost is the moment when God redeems the ancient story of Babel - where humanity was scattered and divided - and gathers the nations together, not by erasing their differences but by speaking into them. Diversity is not the problem God overcomes at Pentecost; it is the gift through which God chooses to speak.

This matters profoundly for our congregation today. We are not simply a diverse community by demographic accident. We are, by the very nature of what the Spirit did at Pentecost, a sign of what God is doing in the world - gathering people of every language, culture, and nation into one family.

Come Holy Spirit, set our hearts on fire with love for Jesus.
