From the Rector: A Change of Season

Beginnings and endings. Changing seasons.
Navigating the ups and downs of daily life is
part of our human experience.

Over the summer there has been time to stop,
to think and to pray; to go on holiday; to meet
with family, friends and neighbours; to take a
deep breath. It has been, in a way, an extended
Sabbath. I try to hold as few meetings as
possible in August, recognising that everyone
needs to rest from their labours.

Today, on Back to School Sunday, we mark a
significant change of season: a new beginning for
many of us as pupils, parents, and school staff.
We think of those starting new schools and
new year groups, those entering an important
exam year, and those moving on to university,
apprenticeships or work. This Sunday we give
thanks to God for our schools, and for the
blessing our young people are to us: for the
ways in which they are our teachers, and the
ways in which they show us the face of Jesus.

The coming months will be busy, and richly
so. As we move towards the Kingdom
season and towards Advent and Christmas, the
Church invites us to reflect on a God who is
involved in every season of life; who seeks to
draw near; who infuses our very existence with
meaning; who loves us, calls us by name, and
calls us into his service.

In the busyness of this Michaelmas term, may
we be sustained by God's strength. May he be
our strength and our song. May he hold us in
the palm of his hand, and may we know his

St Francis Wood Parquet Flooring Fund Raiser 2026

Sponsor a Square or Share a Square

The parquet floor at St Francis is a much sort out
and popular asset by many hirers. It's also a great
example of upcycling as it was repurposed from
somewhere else prior to being installed at
St Francis many years ago.

Why are we fundraising?

TARGET £4,000	St Francis Parquet Floor Sponsor a square ² or Share a square ²	TOTAL AREA 98M²

- **WHY** Despite it's age and even though we look after it well, it is good practice to 'feed' the floor every 4-5 years. The weather and wear and tear mean do impact the condition and it is now due for some care and attention.
- **WHEN** booked for October half term.
- **HOW** a gently sanding and oil applied by specialist team to keep it looking great
- **COST** The cost is just under £4,000 for the 98m². To help fund this we are asking for donations of **£40 m²**, or you can contribute to a share. **1/2 = £20** and **1/4 = £10**. Donations can be made via the parish account using either the QR code (see back cover), direct bank transfer or donations in labelled envelope put into the collection plate.
