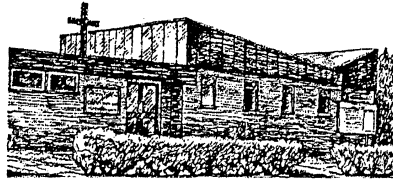
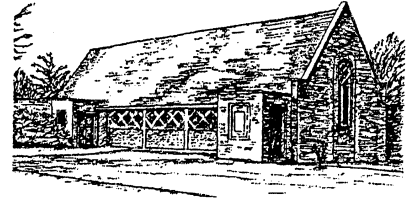

#### NOTES
