## Introduction to PCC Membership and Church Wardens

Every year, a new Parochial Church Council (PCC) and Parish Wardens are elected in our parish.

### What is the PCC?

The PCC is the legal body which has oversight over the building and finances of the parish as well as supporting the mission and ministry of the church community as a whole. PCC members look at pastoral care, evangelism, social justice and ecumenism. Along with the clergy and wardens, they form the leadership of the parish. The PCC has a similar role to the trustees of a charity. There are four meetings a year, and PCC members are also members of the District Church Councils.

### What are Church Wardens?

Church Wardens are Bishop's Officers who act on behalf of the bishop to ensure that the parish is functioning well, with particular concern for building, finance, and clergy wellbeing.

### Why Consider These Roles?

These roles play a vital and life-giving role in our parish, and it is important that we have a good range of people from different backgrounds and with different skills. We're looking for people who have a living faith in Jesus Christ and who want to see God's Kingdom flourish in Langley.
